

Declaration Form

I, the undersigned _____ (hereinafter referred to as the "Participant"), am participating in the "#FindingTAIWAN_2.0: Where We Connect Global Short Film Competition" organized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, ROC (Taiwan) (hereinafter referred to as the "Organizer"), and hereby make the following declaration with full legal responsibility. I understand and agree that any violation of the following terms shall render me legally liable.

1. The Participant confirms that they have carefully read and understood the competition rules and related regulations. Should the registration be incomplete, the submitted work fail to meet technical or eligibility requirements, or the file format be unreadable—and if due to factors beyond the Organizer's control (such as computer, internet, telephone, or technical issues) the submission is delayed, lost, erroneous, unidentifiable, or damaged—this may result in disqualification, without the right to object. The Organizer shall not be held liable if contact information is incomplete or incorrect, preventing notification of results.
2. Any audiovisual work that has previously won awards in competitions held by government agencies or private organizations, or has been used for commercial purposes, is not eligible for this competition.
3. The Participant guarantees that all components of the submitted audiovisual work—including but not limited to visuals, audio, music, text, storyline, and characters—are original, or properly licensed from co-authors or rights holders. The work does not infringe upon any third-party copyright, patent, trademark, or other intellectual property rights. Should any infringement or unlawful content be discovered, the Organizer reserves the right to revoke participation or awards and to reclaim any prizes. The Participant shall bear full legal responsibility; the Organizer shall not be held liable.

4. If the content of the submission contains obscenity, violence, pornography, defamation, or otherwise violates public order and morality, or if the Participant intentionally conceals ineligibility, the Organizer reserves the right to disqualify the Participant, who shall bear all resulting legal consequences.
5. The Participant agrees that from the moment of registration, the economic rights of any winning work (including but not limited to music, still frames, and video clips) are licensed to the Organizer and its authorized sublicensees free of charge. This license grants the Organizer the right to reproduce, adapt, edit, publicly exhibit, broadcast, transmit, recite, and distribute the work for non-commercial promotional use, without limitations on time, frequency, or territory.
6. For any matters not addressed in this affidavit, the Organizer reserves the right to add, remove, or amend the terms of the competition. Any such updates will be announced on the official competition website. If the Participant does not accept the revised terms, they may withdraw from the competition.
